# THE SPRINT COURSE



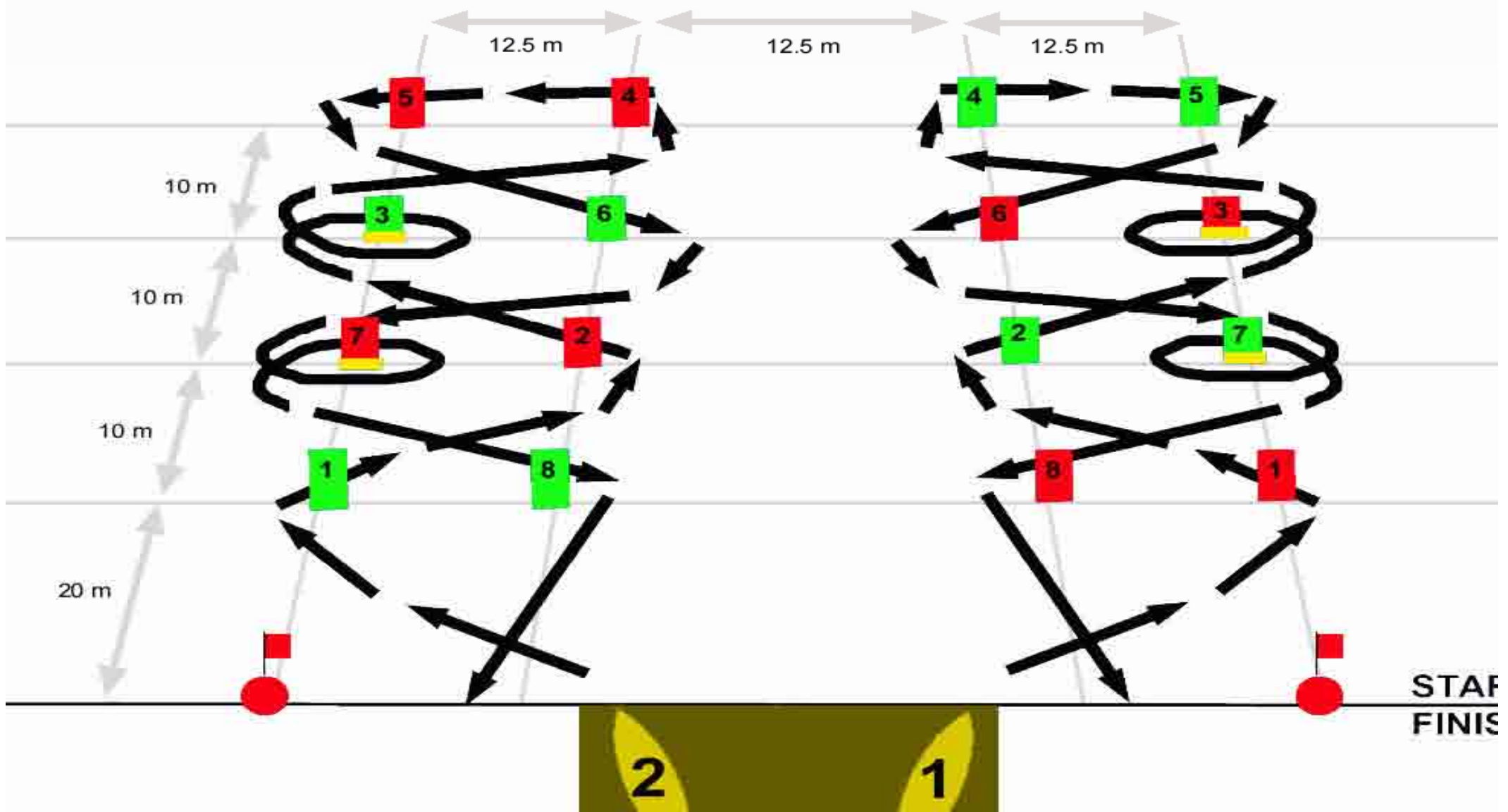

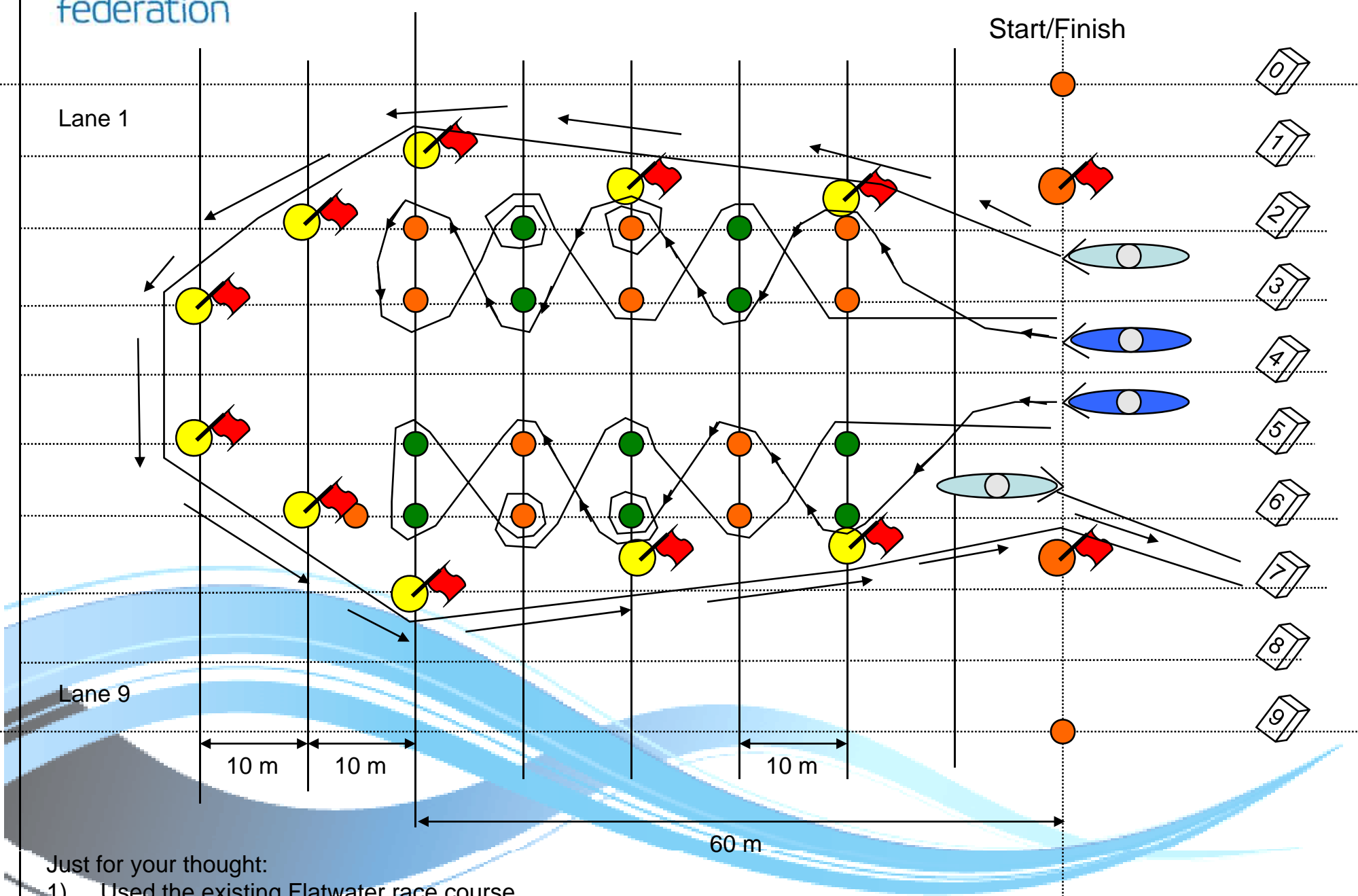


Just for your thought:

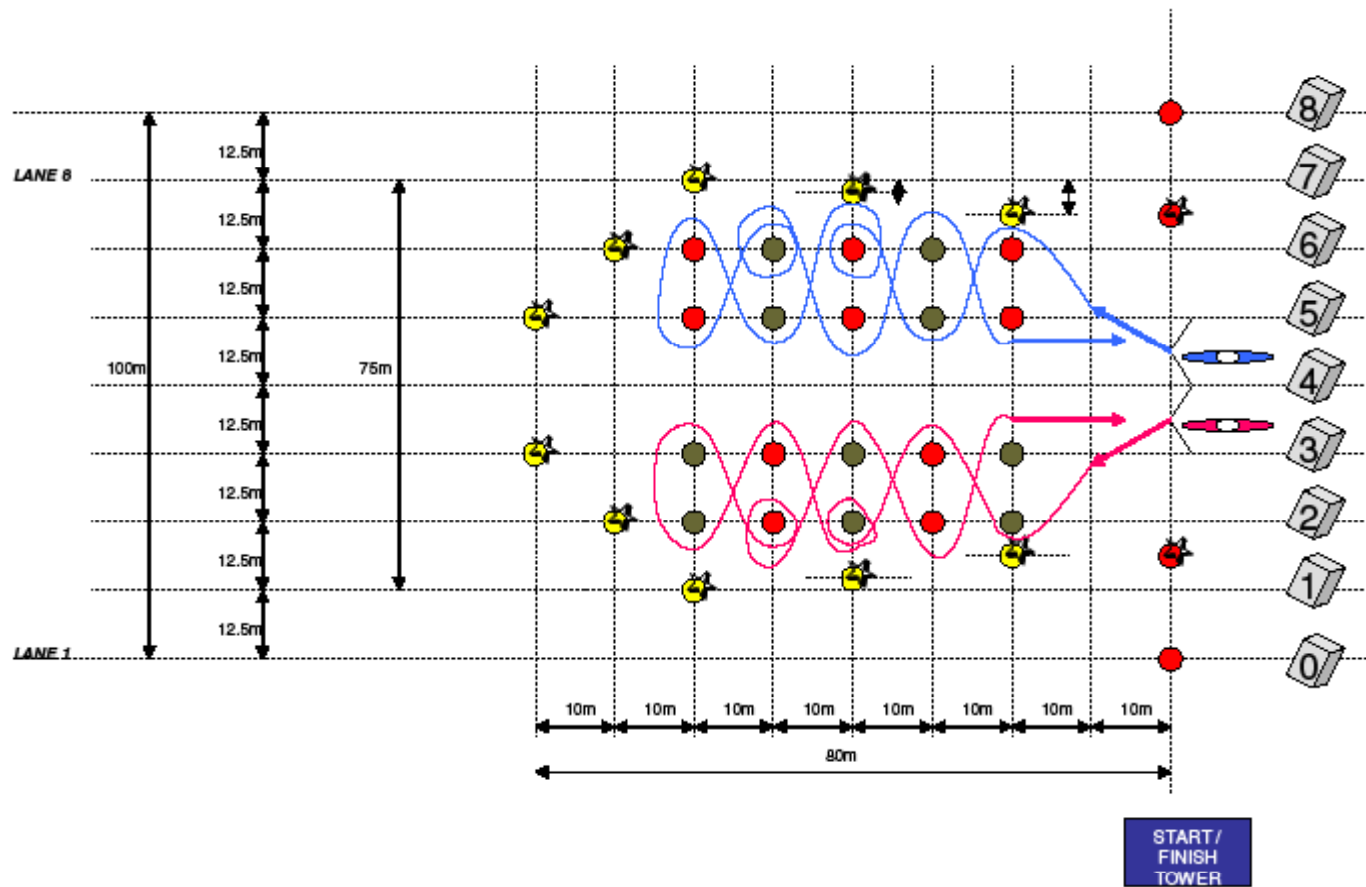
- 1) Used the existing Flatwater race course
